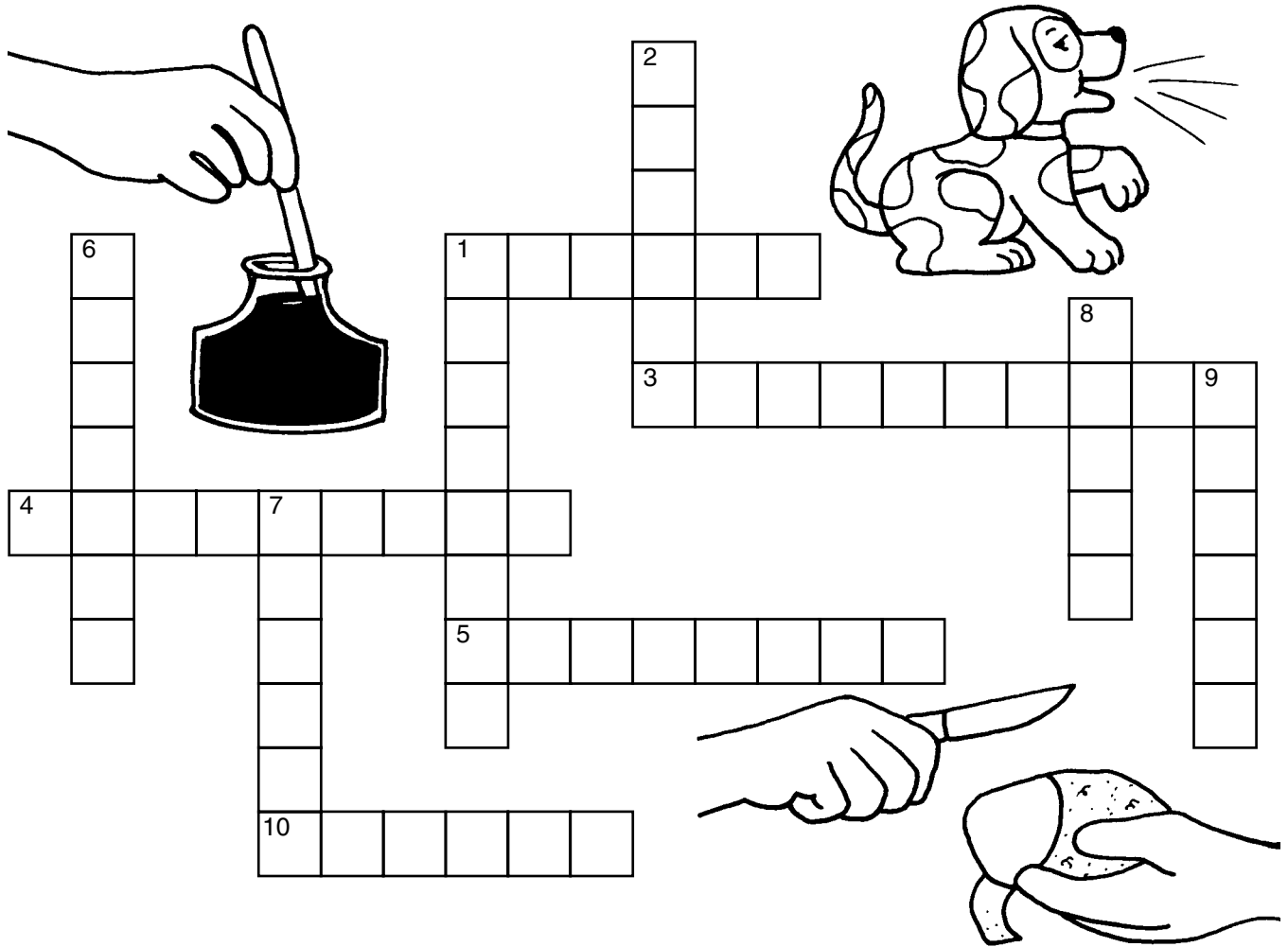




Puzzling Endings

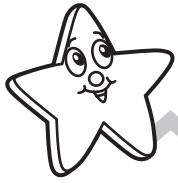

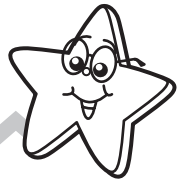
